

What is Title IX?

Title IX states that “No person in the United States shall, on the basis of sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any educational program or activity receiving financial assistance.”

What Is BRTC’s Stance on Sexual Violence and Discrimination?

Members of the Black River Technical College (BRTC) community have the right to be free from sexual misconduct. All members of the campus community are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that does not infringe upon the rights of others. BRTC has a zero-tolerance policy for gender-based misconduct. When an allegation of misconduct is brought to an appropriate administrator’s attention, and an individual is found responsible for sexual discrimination, serious sanctions will be used to reasonably ensure that such actions are never repeated. BRTC has investigative procedures in place to reaffirm these principles and to provide recourse for individuals whose rights have been violated. These procedures are intended to define community expectations and to establish a mechanism for determining when those expectations have been violated.

Black River Technical College also complies with the 2013 Violence Against Women Act (VAWA)– Section 304. In compliance with VAWA, BRTC has established policies, procedures, resources, and educational programming to address sexual assault, dating violence, domestic violence, and stalking, to affirm BRTC students and employees are provided with a safe learning and working environment.

The health, safety, and well-being of the public and the college community are of primary concern at BRTC. *If you or someone you know may be a victim of any form of sexual discrimination, you are strongly encouraged to seek immediate assistance.*
